AREAS OF INTEREST

Beginning with the 2011 Spring Cycle, The Foundation's Peace & Justice priority area will be renamed **Social Justice & Drug Policy Reform**. Within Social Justice & Drug Policy Reform, The Foundation will continue to support:

- **Government accountability**, specifically addressing detention standards, secret criminal proceedings and illegal monitoring, and the concentration of executive branch authority.
- **Human rights field-building** to support the development of a global human rights movement through: 1) the use of a human rights framework to advance specific policy goals and 2) human rights education and training.
- **Fair Application of the Law** will continue to support *due process and immigration and economic justice*.

However, the issue of *sentencing, penalties and incarceration* (previously funded under Fair Application of the Law) will now form part of a new sub-priority area for **Drug Policy Reform**. This area will support the following issues:

- Legalization and Decriminalization
- Medical Research and Application of Illegal Drugs
- Race, Arrest and Incarceration (including alternatives to incarceration)
- U.S. Foreign Policy

As with our other priority areas, we will seek to support the strategies of Public Awareness (Strategic Communications), Public Policy Advocacy, Organizing, Litigation and Research within drug policy reform work.
